

# School Tour Report

Empowering young people for a Safer Internet.





### About

The goal of the school tour is to create online safety awareness in a 3 weeks activation where volunteers will visit 500 schools reaching 100,000 students simultaneously across Nigeria to facilitate online safety lessons and distribute online safety tool kits to schools and students.



### Problem Statement

The widespread use of the Internet and new communication technologies has been a powerful engine for growth, learning and the creation of new jobs which has helped to improve the quality of life for many including young people as it provides them access to education, entertainment and skills for their future employability.

While the Internet is a great way to access quality content and services, it can also serve the purpose of ill-intentioned people. Globally, there are more than 2.2 billion people under the age of 18 years, making young people the biggest vulnerable group in our societies.



### Solution

Educating young people on how they can navigate the internet to ensure they are protected, respected and empowered online.



### School tour 2024

The school tour took place in **22 states in Nigeria between 1st of May - 15th of June 2024.** Through the school tour we were able to reach over **70,000 students in 437 schools** sharing online safety lessons and safety measures. Our volunteers covered 4 major topics which include:
